

Mandamus is the proper remedy when it is shown that a clear legal right exists to the performance of a clear legal duty by public officer and that no other legal remedies are available. See <u>Plymel v. Moore</u>, 770 So.2d 242 (Fla. 1st DCA 2000); <u>Holcomb v. Department of Corrections</u>, 609 So.2d 751 (Fla. 1st DCA 1992); <u>Hatten v. State</u>, 561 So.2d 562 (Fla. 1990) and; <u>Shea v. Cochran</u>, 680 So.2d 628 (Fla. 4th DCA 1996).



#### III. NATURE OF RELIEF SOUGHT

The Petitioner seeks this Honorable Court to accept jurisdiction over this matter and parties and grant all relief to which he is entitled to in this proceeding including but not limited to:

- 1. Declare the Petitioner indigent for the purpose of costs and fees in this cause;
